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

### **JCAPCPL** visited TKML and TTSI



# **10** Highlights

### West Zone M&S

- 1. Sales 10320 MT against ABP of 10051 MT (Consistent 8th Month in FY24 achieving over than ABP).
- 2. Achieved 103% sales target against ABP.
- 3. Payment collected 79 crores
- 4. High tensile and skin panel sales is 42% of total sales.

### South Zone M&S

- 1. Sales of 12.3 kT in Nov'23 with OSP compliance of 102%. FY24 YTM ABP compliance is 105%.
- On cumulative basis, JCAPCPL has crossed the milestone of 3 Lakh MT sales to HMIL in Nov'23. While it took 49 months to cross 1 Lakh MT sales, further 30 months to cross 2 Lakh MT sales, we had achieved 3 Lakh MT milestone in further 23 months itself thus indicating consistent ramp up in supplies & SOB with HMIL.
- FY24 YTM JCAPCPL South Region CR SOB increased to 27 % (From 23% in FY23).

### **North Zone**

- 1. MSIL production is expected to around 89 K in North as per the revised plan . Honda production is also expected to be as per the plan of 13.5 K.
- We could sell around 15 kt against a plan of 16kt in-spite of production revision by MSIL, production constraint at SPC , issues in Skin; HSS and HCIL direct despatches.
- 3. CR MSIL SOB was 42 % and HCIL was 21% in Nov'23 which is higher than ABP
- Sales of diverted/downgraded materials through GTM (Distribution + Magic box+ Narrow slits) increased to 204 MT in Oct'23.
- 5. High Tensile and skin panel sales is 33 % of Total Sales.
- 6. Payment collected 135 Crores against plan of 115 Crores.
- 3 new sizes (2 skin and 1 Inner ) for the new Y17 model of MSIL have been received for trails and same will be sent to Japan in the 1st week of Dec'23.
- T1 trial was found successful in MSIL sizes of BDI YOM - 0.6\*1025 . T2 trail lot will be supplied in Dec 2023.
- 9. We also have received trial confirmation of 14 new SKU from HCIL (8 Skin and 6 Inner ) for the new 3RA model and we are in process of firming the delivery timelines with them .
- 10. We have received enquiry of 10 new sizes from Metal one for their new Imasen business. we have supplied 4 SKU on 30th Nov (12 MT) and 6 others will be supplied in the first week of Dec'23. The business potential is around 100 TPM.
- 11. Trail successful in 1 size each in BellSonica and NMPL Haridwar with monthly potential of 40 TPM.
